order to be recycled.

Below is a list of acceptable and non-acceptable items
for the program:

List of Acceptable Items for Clothing and Textile Bin:

Clothing Items: Blouses, Coats, Jackets, Dresses, Pants, Shirts, Swimsuits, Suits, Ties, Tuxedos, Sweaters, Undergarments, Halloween Costumes, Pet Clothing, Jeans, Sweatshirts, Hats, Scarves, Shoes

Clothing Accessories: Purses, Handbags, Backpacks, Tote bags, and Belts.

Household Textiles: Bedspreads, Sheets, Blankets, Drapes, Sofa Covers, Quilts, Towels, Washcloths, Table and Dining Cloths and Linens, Curtains, Comforters, Duvets, Soft Toys (stuffed animals & plush toys)

List of Unacceptable Items:

Pillows, Sleeping Bags, Mattresses, Rugs, Carpet, Cushions, Foam Furniture, Foam Mats, Vinyl Shower Curtains, Large Luggage, Wet Items, Smelly or Moldy Items

Residents may drop-off recyclable textiles at any time (24 hours a day, 365 days a year)
