As are you and your family, my wife and myself and my entire team is devastated by this tragedy. My wife and my team and Myself are looking forward to continue to help and serve our community and will be involved in the coming days and weeks and months to assist victims of this tragedy.

With that said, We do however have emergency highland park patients scheduled tomorrow at 1770 1st street suite 310. To be clear, these are dental emergencies not related to this tragedy in any way to my knowledge. When looking at the map I noticed the garage to enter 1770 1st street does not appear to be blocked off. And our patients can enter our offices directly from the garage without ever stepping foot onto the crime scene if the garage is not a part of the crime scene. And our business is not a store front. It is on the 3rd floor. We did close today. And I considered closing in general and for normal things that can wait but tomorrows procedures are emergencies and urgent. And I do not want to further burden our community right now by not being able to provide care.

I do potentially have the option of seeing our highland park patients in our Skokie location if the garage and garage access to 1770 first is to be closed.

I understand it may be difficult to respond to my email in the difficult time. Please advise me at your earliest convenience.

I will be notifying my staff now to potentially be ready to redirect to Skokie.

Dear Mayor Rotering,

We met recently at Northwestern's graduation. Thank you for your leadership during this terrible time for our community. I know how busy you are and how difficult the week has been, so I don't make this request lightly.

had an encounter with Crimo about a week before the tragedy: as she was leaving her apartment on Central, she saw him on her back staircase. We now know he was investigating the rooftop access from the adjoining building. She was very disturbed by the encounter and considered taking his picture and giving it to the police. He was intimidating, however, and so she got away as fast as she could.

She has been interviewed several times by the police and the FBI about this. They have assured her she did nothing wrong and there is nothing she could have done.

I'm writing because, those reassurances notwithstanding, she is having a lot of trouble with this incident. She worries that somehow if she had taken the picture, law enforcement would have been able to take action that would have prevented what happened.

I think it would be helpful for a senior official from the city — the police chief, or you based on information from the police chief — to talk to Jill and give her a specific, technical/legal explanation of why this would have occurred even if she had taken a picture and made a report. For example, that the police would have lacked a basis to confiscate his weapons based on a report of possible trespassing, or that the department would not have made the connection to the upcoming parade and taken steps to secure the rooftop based on such a report, or that they lacked the resources to place him under surveillance even if they did have concerns.

s a logical thinker, and I believe what would help her process this is hearing the real scenarios about how the police would and would not have reacted to the report. General reassurances from her brother aren't getting it done.

Would it be possible for someone to reach out with that level of detail, to help set her mind at ease?



BEST PRACTICES/NATIONAL GUIDELINES LEARNED OVER YEARS OF MASS CASUALTY CRIMES

We – our network of families from other mass shootings over many years – have repeatedly gone in after mass shootings to advocate for victims who are too traumatized to speak for themselves and to help counties, cities and states understand what is actually needed for victims and how best to help. This best practices/national guidelines list has been put together in order to help you.

After a mass shooting, your community will become a circus of media, well-wishers, gun violence prevention (gvp) groups, those wanting TV exposure to promote their own organization for fundraising opportunities, self-described "experts" also wanting media attention, and inappropriate calls for museum archiving for temporary memorials before family members are even buried. You will also be inundated with calls from community nonprofits from other mass shootings offering their "help." Depending on the nonprofit, what they will tell you may result in the re-traumatization and re-victimization of those suffering most.

Typically, people think that federal and/or state victim agencies help to take care of things, and while helpful, they don't even scratch the surface of what is actually needed. Here is what we learned from the Victim/Survivor perspective to help you while making sure that victims are not re-victimized:

FUNDRAISING:

— Immediately establish one, centralized fund and make certain that 100% of the donations collected from Americans/Corporations/Donors worldwide actually go DIRECTLY TO the victims/survivors. We — over 130 parents of murdered children, those injured and those who survived from Columbine, Va Tech, NIU, Tucson, Aurora, Oak Creek Sikh Temple, Newtown, Alturas, Santa Barbara (Isla Vista), Roseburg, San Bernardino, Orlando Pulse Night Club, Las Vegas as well as one of the 9/11 fathers who worked with Sen. Ted Kennedy to make sure victims were compensated — have already established and/or endorsed this centralized fund called The National Compassion Fund via the National Center for Victims of Crime. The Fund is designed to take care of ALL victims: families of the deceased, those shot, injured and those who survived.

This helps to end the decades of re-victimization and makes sure donor intent is actually fulfilled. Money collected through other funds usually go everywhere but to the victims themselves. It also helps to eliminate fraud and keep victim privacy. (Note: Historically about 10% of donations won't be able to be verified so keep that in mind).

The NCF exists solely to distribute tax-deductible donations to victims of mass tragedy. The Fund activates when a mass tragedy happens, collects donations, distributes those funds directly to the victims and then closes down -- until the next mass tragedy occurs. We encourage this Fund to stay open until after the one-year mark.

- Establish a credible, point person/s to birddog non-profits to expose fraudulent funds and report them to law enforcement. This should be immediately done by the State Attorney General's office who oversees this kind of thing. Manage fundraising *immediately*.

- --Be transparent about what the funds will be used for. This has been accomplished in the past by setting up two funds: One for Victims and the other for Community needs.
- --Do not just automatically set up funds for Scholarships or Memorials without speaking to the family members of the deceased for whom it's for. Do the victims' families want that done? What would they like done?
- Issue an Immediate release of emergency funds directly to victims (usually the state victim compensation fund can do this). We suggest \$5K immediately once victims are all identified. Let them know help is coming. Incomes for some families have been cut in half. Stress comes also in the form of not knowing how they are going to pay bills while out of work and from belongings (like personal belongings phones, etc. being confiscated during the investigation).

FUNERALS:

- A point person is needed to connect victims with the Office of Victims Assistance (and VOC in their states) that can help with burial expenses (typically, victims have not known about this in the past and neither have many victim advocates) and help them fill out any paperwork. PTSD takes hold right away and filling out paperwork can be overwhelming. Let families know that it is available to help financially; that helps to alleviate stress.
- **This should be done for the entire victim base, not only families of the deceased. Here are state victim comp offices: http://www.nacvcb.org/index.asp?sid=6
- -- Provide security at funeral services and establish national guidelines for communities to follow when protestors (such as the Westboro Baptist Church) wish to make a media event out of a private day of mourning. Establish minimum distances and proximity requirements to ensure that funeral services are not desecrated.
- -- Pact immediately with hotel and airlines and Uber/Lyft to help families who must fly in to identify their loved ones bodies or be at their hospital bedside.

MEDIA/COMMUNICATION:

- Provide interpreters
- -- Make sure there are trauma specialists who can be on call 24/7.
- -- NoNotoriety Policy. Make sure First Responders and Politicians (ANYONE deemed to speak to the media) are all on the same page, focusing on the victims and heroes and not the shooter. Teach people about media sensitivity not only for <u>public safety</u> reasons but to stop re-victimizing victims. There IS a proven contagion effect and copycats or threats will definitely follow. <u>www.nonotoriety.com</u>
- -- Make sure all key first responders (law enforcement) have cell phone numbers of city and community leaders and vice versa. **Designate one or two competent people to organize** all of this for the sake of the victims and communities.
- —Language is important and the words someone uses can be very re-victimizing to those directly impacted. For instance, using the word "lost" when referring to a child so violently ripped from one's family. Family members shot and killed were not "lost." They were murdered, taken from our families, lives stolen, stolen from us.

Similarly with the use of 'anniversary' of the shooting. It is nothing to celebrate and many prefer using the words "year mark" as in the first year-mark.

After a mass shooting, never say, "It could have been worse." For families of the deceased, it can get no worse.

Avoid the word "healing" because for families of the deceased, there is only the path of learning how to cope and manage the trauma.

- -- Assist families/survivors in controlling the use of images of the deceased. Frequently, media outlets and fundraising groups will gather images of the victims from the internet and use them without consent of the owners of those images. Misuse of images of the victims re-victimizes the survivors and disrespects the deceased. Again, much of this can be avoided by having approved images released through the wire services for use by news media outlets.
- Have victim advocates assist families of the deceased/injured also with putting together a statement for the press about their loved one. While in horrible grief, we have been hounded in the past by the media to do this and if not done, the media puts up their own information, thereby revictimizing victims' families yet again.
- Provide professional Communications person to help victims with the crushing amount of media and groups reaching out to try to get to the victims. There is simply no way for them to sift through any of it. The scope is beyond comprehension.
- Give victims the option of being able to talk to other families of the deceased and survivors of past mass casualty crimes so you can have questions answered by those who know, who have lived through it, and be prepared for what will be experienced in both the short-term and long-term. Victim advocates, while well-meaning, can add more stress and others who have been through these tragedies who have the experience and knowledge, understanding and sensitivity, should work in conjunction with advocates to reduce stress. Usually the FBI creates a wall. *That is the opposite of what should be happening.*
- -- Have victims from previous mass casualty crimes work with politicians and those in the community so the proper words and language are used when speaking to and about victims of crime. Make sure they have the proper pronunciations of names of the deceased. (For example, those who are deceased are not "lost" rather they were murdered, shot and killed, taken).
- -- A name and number from both federal and local law enforcement to each family for other issues that always arise (stalking, death threats, bullying on social media, fraudulent victims funds, conspiracy theorists, violation of privacy issues, and many others such as how to remove your home address and phone number from Internet people search sites or remove fraudulent social media accounts).
- -- After the mass casualty crime, property will be confiscated. This creates its own issues for victims in regards to needing phones, medical equipment, etc. After the investigation, property will be returned. For families of the deceased, it is an excruciatingly hard day. If there is a trial, it will be longer. But, please coordinate with trauma specialists for survivors on these days.

SCHOOL CHILDREN:

- Local School District/Principal should be aware that it is re-victimizing for families to have their deceased loved ones immediately purged out of the school's files. Offer to talk to each family – either directly or through the victim's advocate – to see what their individual wishes are. Some want to gather up their children's or loved ones records.

In addition, certain activities designed to create a perception of safety for returning survivors (such as the presence of increased armed security personnel, active shooter drills and clear backpacks) have added to, not reduced, feelings of trauma and victimization for students.

- Bereavement counselors and trauma specialists for schoolchildren and teachers in schools both
 directly inside the community impacted and indirectly in neighboring communities when needed. It will be
 a scary time for both children and teachers/adults whether the shooting/terrorist attack impacted them
 directly or not.
- Behavioral health programs should be proactive, not reactive, in nature. Many children may not recognize the need to seek care, particularly teenagers. In addition, seeking care may be challenged by stigma, fear, availability of resources and payments. The goal of the school and community programs should be proactive and long-term in nature and include population-based screening, navigation to appropriate, individualized services and management of progress over time.
- Of utmost importance is having an alternative for school kids who are so traumatized that they are not sure they can finish their education. We need something to help them (We have seen kids go from straight A's to C's and the school gives no alternative to finish their education). There are K12 programs already in 33 states. There are also Independent Study programs at schools.

HOW POLITICIANS CAN TRULY HELP:

- --Work with D.A/Coroner's office to keep autopsy photos and reports from being made public. It should be up to the individual families as there are other siblings, relatives, etc. that are also impacted.
- -- ASK the families what THEY want instead of doing what city officials want. In one incident, only a week to 10 days after the shooting, families were *unbelievably* asked if they wanted to attend a memorial inside the building of their loved ones killing ground. Oftentimes, memorials, scholarships and city events are set up without knowledge or any input from the families themselves. This is the opposite of what should be happening.
- -- Work to get Priority Processing of SSA for victim/survivors who are deemed unable to work for life as a result of a mass casualty crime.
- Work to extend Medicare, Medicaid and CHIP for those who need it a year after the final appointment at the hospital for medications, supplies and care for those shot and trying to heal.
- In the past, hospitals have generously absorbed the initial bills of the victims (thereby relieving overwhelming stress). The city or state should reach out to see if this is possible.
- -- Make sure cities immediately apply for federal and state grants for mental health. There are MULTI-MILLION dollar grants that can come in later.
- Point people for the victim base to make Worker Comp claims (if applicable) go smoothly so victims aren't denied crucial medical care and medications (which happened in San Bernardino).

HOW BUSINESSES CAN TRULY HELP:

-- Immediate point people on the victim contingent side and community side who can work together to find and fulfill short-term help (childcare, pet care, getting groceries, shoveling sidewalks, mowing lawns, help filling out forms and a host of other vital, day-to-day help that most people don't even think about). Businesses in the community often want to offer help.

- -- Coordination of efforts between businesses wanting to give gift cards to the families and the need ... they will flood in from everywhere. If it is high-profile, letters will flood in as well for the victims.
- Help victims/survivors find disability accessible housing, transportation, etc. (see below)
- Medical Supply store gift cards.

FIRST RESPONDERS:

- -- Make sure victims can connect with First Responders who helped them if they want. It can help all involved.
- -- Bring in other First Responder brothers and sisters who have been through similar incidents so those uniformed who have been traumatized have emotional support. Medical teams need the same.

OTHER ISSUES:

Meal Trains

When organizing meal trains for victims and/or family members, it is important to keep addresses private and off the Internet for public consumption for the sake of the victim bases' safety. In Parkland, we found multiple times that people would sign up to "help" for meal trains with an ulterior motive to gain the victims' families and survivors' addresses for their own personal gain. To avoid this, we had multiple volunteers set up on a nightly basis to truly help on the meal train. We had a volunteer pick up from the restaurant, then hand the food off to another person Authorized by the families to have the home address and deliver the food to the location. This maintains privacy.

- Ambulance chasing lawyers will always come in. Make sure that families know there are lawyers at the NCVC and elsewhere who can provide free consultation until they find their own lawyer.

"Resiliency Centers"

This can be a bone of contention for those directly impacted as victims watch hundreds of thousands of dollars poured into establishing a "Resiliency Center" while they themselves cannot pay bills. Victims directly impacted should be asked if they want this. Also, there is a real concern for those out of state who cannot partake of the Center and then watch their portion of donations meant for them go into a building, sometimes that costs upwards of \$1 million.

Museums

Directly impacted communities may be immediately contacted by museum curators in the aftermath of a mass shooting who will encourage the collection of items from temporary memorials. It is often done even before families have a chance to bury their children, which we find disrespectful.

Allow families and survivors to bury their children and later lead the conversation of any memorialization, scholarships, benches, and remembrance when *they* are ready. First foremost, respect the victims' families wishes.

The intent behind objects left at temporary memorials, usually outdoors, is part of the collective grieving process. The first consideration should always be the physical, emotional, spiritual, and financial needs of victims—those directly impacted by a mass shooting.

If local communities seek to document the temporary memorials, make sure that the families, not museum curators, are allowed to chose what they would like to keep from those public memorials, first and foremost.

We find it extremely distasteful to try to create a tourist attraction off the murders of our loved ones.

SOCIAL MEDIA:

- Establish one website where victims/survivors can immediately go to get information.
- Establish a social media presence so those in the community can send messages of love to the victims. Love to Aurora. Love to Orlando. Love to Las Vegas. Love to Parkland. Love to Santa Fe. It helps to actually see that others care.

WHAT CITY OFFICIALS/MEDICAL TEAMS NEED TO KNOW FOR THOSE CATASTROPHICALLY INJURED:

- --Victims face multiple surgeries over years. Some want to try Stem-cell treatment. Pain management is a big need.
- -Possible future amputations.
- -- Repeated trips to ER (sometimes the fear is greater than the problem)

THERE WILL BE A NEED FOR:

- --Prosthetics
- --Reclining wheelchairs so the stress is off the body and patients won't get sores.
- --Pressure relief mattresses/beds (one that is easy to get out of so that has the adjustable bed bases, which are costly).
- -New and/or Accessible Housing (if they rent) or help with moving homes, packing, unpacking OR changes to existing housing to make it handicap accessible (which includes ramps, widening doors, lowering countertops, etc., and changing the carpet to allow the wheelchairs to move more easily over them).

We were able to get the local **Home Depot** to help us behind the scenes in Aurora as well as a local realtor to help along with construction workers who agreed to help one of the most injured survivors.

- -Handicapped accessible vans are <u>very important</u>, transportation to and from rehabilitation sessions (in many mass shootings, it is hard to find vans for our victims and they are very expensive).
- -HOMECARE and the expense that comes with that. Some victims will not be able to be left alone and, in fact, I would suggest they are not left alone as the nightmares are severe. That usually falls on the family, but it exhausts an already traumatized family member. Everything from getting groceries to getting to and from doctor offices, etc.
- --Colostomy bags and the expense that comes with changing those out all the time.
- --Physical therapy costs can be very high because often it last years and many of the places don't take Medicare.

- --As they heal, some may need specially equipped cars for handicap accessible driving. They will want this power to heal mentally as well.
- --Medical Supply store GIFT CARDS would help as some of those expenses are not covered by Medicare. Wheelchairs are very expensive and transportation is outrageously priced (i.e. vans).
- -Pain management help from nerve pain.
- -Cognitive problems so help filling out the simplest of forms (hence, help needed filling out Medicare forms from friends or family or medical workers).
- -Speech therapist help or learning to communicate differently (brain injured will find this).
- -- Mental support, especially if their family is small or they are far from home.
- --PTSD issues

Big problem afterwards for catastrophically injured is finding employment that can actually SUSTAIN A LIFE as employers don't really want to hire a person that they know will have ongoing medical issues and those for the badly disabled don't provide a living wage.

*** Physical wounds and/or overwhelming grief are compounded by the lack of coordination and sensitivity after mass casualty crimes and it truly needs to change. Emotional wounds are real wounds. Our families care about ALL victims. ***

LONGER TERM LEGISLATIVE ISSUES:

Establish a Mass Casualty Act National Protocol encompassing all things covered here.

Extend Medicare for those who need it a year after the final appointment at the hospital for medications, supplies and care for those shot and trying to heal.

Mandate Priority Processing of SSA for victim/survivors who are deemed unable to work for life as a result.

Deem Mass Casualty Crimes Victims as a class.
