## Who We Are

ITC is a non-profit partnership of NGOs specializing in both proactive and reactive emergency preparedness, building resilience and trauma care. Working closely with Home Front Command and key government ministries, municipalities, NGO's and the private sector, we strengthen individuals and communities to cope better with crisis and build sustainable resilience. For nearly two decades, ITC has prioritized its work to tackle crises, providing emergency preparedness initiatives and post-trauma community rehabilitation - leveraging our unique knowledge and expertise. We have invested in both prevention and expediting recovery from crises.

We are the leaders in the field of trauma in size, impact and innovation.

## What We Do

## Support of ITC's mission in helping people in crisis is the most fundamental expression of human solidarity.

## DIRECT TRAUMA CARE

Professional, experienced teams of clinical service providers, identify needs and provide short term, long term and focused trauma care.

## PROFESSIONAL TRAINING AND SUPPORT

Caring can hurt. We are dedicated to ensuring that trauma care professionals including health, welfare, social and educational providers remain not only current in their knowledge and skills but also healthy, stable and resilient, we provide caregivers with both professional and personal support.

## EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS

ITC prepares cities, local councils, organizations and businesses both nationally and internationally for crisis today and well into the future. Preparing emergency preparedness protocols and providing a cost effective way to train local professionals, emergency service personnel, volunteers, community service providers, educational, health teams and leaders from the local business communities.

## Ukraine crisis

Since 2014, ITC has been supporting and training professionals in Ukraine. Currently, ITC supports a virtual community of approximately 2,500 Ukrainian trauma professionals, including doctors, psychologists, psychiatrists and social workers. The aim is to develop a significant professional cadre, composed of Ukrainian trauma specialists. Within the Ukraine Envelope: Poland, Moldova, Hungary, Bulgaria, the Czech Republic and Montenegro, ITC trains staff at refugee absorption sites (volunteers, center managers, social workers, community leaders, support professionals-nurses and teachers) in emotional first aid, trauma care and self-care tools, team preservation and reduction of attrition.

In Israel, ITC is training local council teams responsible for the care and support of new immigrants and refugees from Ukraine in provision of emotional first aid, identifying trauma and signs of distress, grief and bereavement, self-care tools. ITC also works with immigration and absorption teams (including Jewish Agency teams, government ministries, social workers and educational consultants) that provide support for new immigrants and refugees.

## Other Challenges:

On-going support for medical teams: From the very outset of the COVID-19 pandemic, many medical teams have worked extremely long hours in high-pressure environments. This pandemic has demanded extraordinary physical and mental effort from these healthcare workers. ITC is working with teams who require specialized attention to their wellbeing, tools to cope with the psychosocial pressure, to sustain and strengthen their resilience and to learn coping skills for themselves and their patients.

Emergency preparedness: The country is at a critical juncture and needs to be ready at any given moment to fight on multiple fronts including a terror war in Gaza and the West Bank, a conventional war on the Syrian/Lebanon borders and an armed uprising throughout the country. In any of these scenarios, natural disasters, terror or war there is also a possibility of mass evacuation of the populace from border regions. The new reality is that each Local Council Authority and community will be responsible for its own emergency preparedness and response. ITC is working with communities on the frontline to build their emergency preparedness and response capacity.

## Achievements

- ITC's 12 Resilience Centers have become the central address for immediate, pro-active intervention, training and real time relief. Each Resilience Center (5 Southern centers, 4 Judea and Samaria, Ashkelon, Netivot and Bedouin Resilience Center) prepares customized emergency preparedness programs for local communities based on their needs, population and culture, creates a continuum of care including providing trauma-focused psychological treatment and builds community resilience by developing cohesion, teaching coping skills and forming volunteer emergency response teams.
- ADEPT Academy for Domestic Emergency Preparedness and Training (ADEPT) a partnership with Home Front Command. The Academy provides municipal community leaders and institutions with the tools required to aid their communities in preventing, protecting, responding to, and recovering from both manmade and natural disasters.
- International efforts Israel's experience preparing for and coping with crisis and terror makes Israeli trauma experts amongst the most knowledgeable on the global map. Our international work relies on experience and concepts developed over many years in emergency preparedness and trauma care in Israel. Teams of ITC experts share their knowledge and help local professionals establish recovery and rehabilitation programs in response to both manmade and natural disasters. ITC trains local care providers leaving behind a more robust civilian resilience network.

Police responded to a threat of a shooting at HP Hospital this evening, immediately before VP Harris arrived in town. A husband was with his wife in the ER and was upset at her treatment care and then threatened staff. He was charged with disorderly conduct.

We will not have a press briefing tomorrow; rather, we will issue communication with a focus on community care, crisis support and services. A morning update will be drafted and then released via all modalities.

I spoke to Jeff Haydon at Ravinia Festival this evening and they will be cancelling their performance through next Tuesday. Given that a portion of our business district is closed with limited access to parking, and given that our staff resources are directed toward the shooting investigation and community patrol, we have limited resources to be able to serve Ravinia Festival, particularly given the sold out Sheryl Crow concert. We will be reviewing Ravinia's statement before it is issued.

## The Story

The US is reeling from another mass shooting.

## Where？

Highland Park，Chicago．Like many Americans，people in the Chicago suburb were celebrating Independence Day with a parade．But then a gunman on a rooftop fired more than 70 rounds into the crowd with a legally purchased AR－15－style gun．The attack left at least seven people dead－ including the parents of a toddler．The suspect initially fled by disguising as a woman，sparking an hours－long manhunt．He is now in custody and has been charged with seven counts of first－degree murder．But it wasn＇t the only attack over the weekend．

## Where else？

At least 10 other states．Mass shootings also took place in Massachusetts，Wisconsin，California， Minnesota，Missouri，Colorado，Virginia，Indiana，and New York．At least 57 people were reportedly shot in Chicago outside of the Highland Park shooting．And at least 15 people were reportedly killed and more than 90 injured in more than a dozen mass shootings across the country over the weekend．

## What are people saying？

Illinois Gov．J．B．Pritzker（D）called it＂devastating＂that a celebration of America was＂ripped apart by our uniquely American plague．＂VP Kamala Harris，when visiting Highland Park，told Americans to ＂stand together and speak out＂against＂senseless＂attacks．And President Biden said he＇ll continue to work to end gun violence．The shooting came over a week after Congress passed the most significant gun safety bill in 30 years．And as SCOTUS overturned a New York gun law requiring residents wanting to carry a concealed gun in public to apply for a special license．

## theSkimm

Highland Park now joins a list of more than 300 mass shootings the US has experienced this year alone．And Americans are left once again remembering the victims．

## Update: Ongoing Active Investigation into Active Shooter

An active investigation continues into the shooting at the Highland Park Fourth of July parade. The parade route in downtown Highland Park and the central business district remains an active crime scene; therefore, we highly recommend individuals living in this area to continue to shelter in place. This area entails Green Bay Road to Laurel, to St. Johns to Elm Place. The investigation and most law enforcement personnel are focused on this area. Individuals outside of this area no longer need to shelter in place, however we urge everyone to remain vigilant and immediately report suspicious behavior.

The Lake County Coroner is on the scene assisting with the investigation. Highland Park police are collaborating with the Lake County Major Crimes Task Force, the FBI, Illinois State Police, County and local law enforcement agencies throughout our area. While no one is in custody at this time, a very active apprehension effort is underway.

Individuals with knowledge of the incident, persons of interest, including photo or video evidence from the scene are encouraged to share them with the FBI by calling 1-800-CALL-FBI. Regular updates are also being posted on the City's web site at www.cityhpil.com.

The next press briefing will be held at 4:30 PM July 4, 2022.

All individuals are advised to shelter in place. Law enforcement agencies are searching for the suspect; evidence of a firearm has been recovered. Numerous law enforcement officers are responding and have secured a perimeter around downtown Highland Park. 16 people have been transferred to the hospital; 5 individuals are confirmed deceased.
