## Integration Algorithm

The integration algorithm works as follows:

1. Get the officer badge ID, the dispatch start time, and the dispatch clear time for a given CAD/RMS entry
2. If a video evidence is assigned or uploaded by this officer, and the video recorded was started in between the dispatch start and clear time, there is a potential match
3. There are 3 scenarios once a potential match is found:
4. The video evidence does not have a $\mathrm{CAD} / \mathrm{RMS} \mathrm{ID} \Rightarrow$ metadata from the $\mathrm{CAD} / \mathrm{RMS}$ entry is added to the video metadata on evidence.com, which includes the CAD/RMS ID, category, tags, location
5. The video evidence has a CAD/RMS ID but is in an invalid format $=>$ same action as above
6. The video evidence already has that $\mathrm{CAD} / \mathrm{RMS}$ ID $\Rightarrow$ same action as above since there could be additional metadata that needs to be added from the CAD/RMS entry
7. The video evidence has a valid CAD/RMS ID already $\Rightarrow$ no action is taken since it is assumed the video evidence has already been matched and the integration service does not want to potentially add invalid data

## Integration Reports

The following is an explanation of the individual reports that are generated when a CAD file is processed, what those reports encompass, and how to read them.

## Parser Report

This report covers the results of parsing the CAD file. Each entry in the report is the CAD entry that was parsed and the result of the parsing. Here is a list of the possible results:

Success: Valid Entry: The entry was parsed correctly
Error: Missing Values: The entry is missing required values
Error: Invalid CAD Event Id: The CAD event id in the entry is in an invalid format
Error: Invalid RMS Event Id: The RMS event id in the entry is in an invalid format
Error: start or end datetime either invalid or duration between the two exceed threshold of $\mathbf{8}$ hours: The entry either has a zero duration or the duration exceeds 8 hours
Error: cannot find Evidence.com category that maps to CAD/RMS category: The category in the entry does not map to an agency?s Evidence.com category
Error: cannot find city that maps to CAD/RMS city: The city code in the entry does not map to a city

## Matched CAD Report

This report shows the CAD entries and the evidence that matched. Each entry in this report contains the CAD entry, the evidence information, what metadata was added (if any), and the reason for the action. For example, the last 5 columns are 'Added Categories', 'Added Tags', 'Added CAD/RMS ID', 'Added Location', and 'Match

Reason'. Any of the 'Added' columns can be blank, which means that particular piece of metadata was not added.
For the 'Match Reason', the following values can occur:
E.com ID was not defined: the ID on the evidence already is invalid (this implies a full update)
E.com ID matches the CAD/RMS ID: The ID on the evidence matched the ID from the CAD entry (implies a full update)
E.com already has a valid ID: The ID on the evidence already is valid and is different than the CAD/RMS ID from the entry (this implies nothing is done)

## Unmatched CAD Report

This reports shows all the CAD entries that did not have any matching videos, and why. Possible reasons:
Badge Id does not exist in evidence.com: This error is due to the officer not having an active Evidence.com account. The Badge ID in the CSV file needs to match that officers Badge ID in Evidence.com to properly correlate the video with the event. As a reminder, the recording start time for an Axon video needs to fall between a dispatched \& cleared time for an even in the CSV file per Badge ID.
CAD/RMS record has the same start and end time: This error occurs when the dispatched time and cleared time is exactly the same. We won?t be able to match based on this information unless the video started at the same exact time that the dispatched/cleared time initiated.
CAD/RMS record did not have any matching videos: This error occurs when no matching video is found for a CAD/RMS record in Evidence.com The parser will look for the Badge ID in Evidence.com and try to find recording start times that fall between the dispatched \& cleared window. If nothing is found, this error will appear in the read-only test run.

I am calling for the Highland Park City Government to have an independent investigation conducted relating to the events that had occurred leading to the shooting by Robert Crimo III.

It is vitally important to the community and to everyone in this country to know exactly what happened leading up to the tragedy on 4th July. This is fundamental to make the necessary changes to make sure the same mistakes never occur again. There also needs to be accountability for these mistakes.

Law Enforcement in Highland Park made some incredible statements that are not consistent with Law Enforcement protocol. These statements were illogical and lacked a fundamental understanding of what should have occurred by the Highland Park Police Department in the incident in 2019 involving Robert Crimo.

Deputy Chief Covelli had explained the actions by the Highland Park Police Department. It was explained the Highland Park Police Department needed probable cause to detain Robert Crimo relating to the threats he made to kill his family. It appeared Deputy Chief Covelli was conveying to everyone in the news conference there was no probable cause to take the appropriate action required. It was explained the Highland Park Police Department took no further action on Robert Crimo because the family did not wish to sign complaints. Highland Park Police Department did however, complete a Clear and Present Danger Report to the Illinois State Police. Report had indicated Robert Crimo was a Clear and Present Danger. If Mr. Crimo was a clear and present danger why was he not arrested or charged? Report had clearly indicated he was a Clear and Present

Danger to himself and others. Report had further indicated Robert Crimo was depressed and had history of drug use. The police report had not indicated anything about the previous suicidal call or anything relating to his posts. Why did this occur? It was reported Robert Crimo III had contemplated suicide with a machete. Again, why was this not in the police report? This is crucial information as to the mental instability of Robert Crimo III.

Did anyone from the Highland Park Police Department follow up with the Illinois State Police ? Report does not indicate. The police report was lacking information and was not very detailed relating to events. There are no additional or supplemental reports shown indicating what D.C.F.S. did and when they were contacted. The Incident report indicates everything had occurred on 09-05-19, however the incident report indicates some of the statements occurred on Monday 09-02-19. If this is the case the police report in inaccurate on the date the incident occurred. If there were any issues with taking any particular action by law enforcement on 09-05-19 the Lake County States Attorney needed to be contacted and a Detective assigned to the case for follow up investigation and for charging. A petition could have been requested by the officer or detective to have the Lake County States Attorney to have Mr. Crimo mentally evaluated. This does not appear to have been done. Was this incident assigned to a Detective for further investigation? If not, why did this ocurr? The Incident report was not cleared and approved until 16 September 2019. It is apparent that no further action by the Police Department was taken relating to this incident. Incident report does not make any indication why the officer did not take any action other then removing the weapons for safe keeping. Does not make sense why there is nothing in report pertaining to why an arrest or mental evaluation was not conducted. It is hard to believe that this police report was actually approved by a supervisor. The fact the it took 11 days to approve the police report usually means the report did not go anywhere between 09-05-19 to 09-16-19. Reports that are not approved do not get sent to other agenices. It is unclear once the police report was approved on 0916 -19, this police report went anywhere for further investigation. It is very disheartening.

The family does not have the ultimate say in deciding the action by Law

Enforcement in this incident. The fact that the family did not wish to sign complaints does not negate the responsibility of the Highland Park Police Department to take further action. The police report does not indicate anything about the family not wanting to sign complaints. Why is this not in the police report? The police report does indicate that someone in the household was afraid to be in the house because of the nature of the threats, along with all the knives and weapons. This certainly indicates this threat was credible along with the Clear and Present Danger Report to the State Police. The incident report also indicates Robert Crimo III was not forth coming in the language he used.

Highland Park Police Department had the absolute right and a obligation to detain someone who threatens suicide and certainly somone who threatens to kill their entire family. Furthermore, it is a crime to threaten to kill your entire family which gives officers probable cause to take the necessary action. The Highland Park Police Department was actually required to detain Robert Crimo and should have arrested Robert Crimo III when he threatened to kill his entire family. This did not occur according to Deputy Chief Covelli.

The Highland Park Police Department not only had a right to detain Robert Crimo but they had the right to take him into custody for a mental evaluation by a physician at the hospital. This is actually very common in law enforcement to take this type of action. Police Officers are required to take action if there is a threat to harm or kill anyone, especially if they made statements of being suicidal previously with a machete and made statements of depression along with history of drug use. Highland Park Police Department had information of the mental instability Robert Crimo had. The fact Robert Crimo had in his possession 16 knives and other weapons was another factor to at least arrest him and take him in for a mental evaluation.

Again, this was a crime. The fact that Roberto Crimo threatened to kill his entire family was a crime. Why was this not treated as such? The police report does not indicate how any measures where taken to treat this as a crime or to take appropriate measures to have a mental evaluation done. Why did this ocurr? Did the Highland Park Police Department follow up to investigate social media posts
and songs Robert Crimo had created about killing people. Is there any police reports by the Highland Park Police Department this had occurred? Incident report does not indicate any further investigations or follow ups.

It is very probable if the Highland Park Police Department had taken Robert Crimo in for a mental evaluation and at least arrested him, he would had been flagged from obtaining these weapons.

It is very peculiar what had occurred here. I believe someone could make a reasonable inference that no action was taken by the Highland Park Police Department because the father of Robert Crimo was running for City Mayor at the time. This also needs to be looked into because this does not make any logical sense. There was also supervisor on scene named Sgt. Olsen. It is unclear why the supervisor made these decisions. It is unclear if there are any reports by Sgt. Olsen on this incident. In my experience I have seen officers not want to take someone to the hospital because they have to stay with them for long periods of time. I am not saying this is the case in this incident, however it is a problem in law enforcement and it needs to be looked at.

I have devoted 31 years of my life in a career in law enforcement and it is very difficult to see the mistakes that were so significant. Please take this letter to which it is intended as to help make sure this never happens again. I believe an independent investigation can put alot of questions to rest and help in the healing process.Thank you.

I am a Highland Park native and my heart goes out to all the victims, families and everyone affected by this senseless and horiffic act.

## Condolences to Japanese Association of City Mayors After Assassination of Former Prime Minister Abe

Today, we have sent our sincere condolences to the Japanese Association of City Mayors (JACM), expressing our deepest sympathy and feelings for the staff of JACM and the mayors of Japan as they experience the shocking loss of former Prime Minister Shinzo Abe who was assassinated yesterday in downtown Nara while delivering a campaign speech.

Our relationship with JACM goes back to the 1980s. We have had many workshops and forums to learn and exchange how we can together serve our people. One thing we learned about Japan, contrasting with the United States of America and even other nations, is the lack of guns and gun violence there. There is also a very low crime rate in general. No doubt, Prime Minister Abe's assassination by a 41-year-old man, a former Japan Maritime Self-Defense Officer, will rattle the nation and send shockwaves throughout the world since gun deaths are rare there as compared to here where we continue shooting
people and killing innocent Americans - men, women, children, and babies on a regular basis, like clockwork.

## Here's a Fact.

In 2018, Japan, a country of 125 million people, had nine deaths from firearms. The United States of America, in contrast, had 39,740.

In Japan, the only guns permitted for sale are shotguns and air rifles handguns are outlawed.

To qualify for a firearm license, one must attend an all-day class, pass a written test, and a shooting range test with an accuracy of at least $95 \%$.

In Japan, citizens must also undergo a mental evaluation and drug tests, plus a very rigorous background check, including a review of any criminal record, personal debt, involvement in organized crime, and relationships with family and friends.

The owner of a gun, once he or she is able to possess one, must register the weapon with the police and provide details as to where the gun and ammunition are stored, in separate, locked compartments. Police inspect the gun once a year. Gun owners must go through classes and rigorous examinations every three years.

Mere possession of a gun as part of an organized crime syndicate or gang gets you 15 years in prison. Possessing more than one gun is a crime that carries a prison term of 15 years.

Discharging a gun in a public space can result in a life sentence.

White House Infrastructure Coordinator and United States Conference of Mayors Past President, former New Orleans Mayor Mitch Landrieu will speak on themes across IIJA programs, including Justice40 and Made in America, and how cities should be prioritizing programs that relate to their communities' needs.

Conference Second Vice President Columbus, OH Mayor Andrew Ginther will lay out the Hub's priority BIL federal programs and calendar of supports. Janette Sadik-Khan an expert on road safety will present strategies for crafting impactful applications for the Safe Streets and Roads for All program (SS4A) with leading examples from cities. The session will include a robust discussion among mayors on how you are approaching this historic opportunity and specifically how you are tailoring applications for the SS4A program.

# Treasury Releases More User Guides on Reporting State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds 

Last week on July 1st, the U.S. Department of the Treasury released the State and Local Fiscal Recovery Fund (SLFRF) Proiect and Expenditure Report User Guide along with the Recovery Plan User Guide for the Project and Expenditure Reports and Recovery Plans that are due to Treasury on July 31st. The Project and Expenditure Report User Guide includes a Frequently Asked Questions section to address common reporting concerns. ## Condolences to Japanese Association of City Mayors After Assassination of Former Prime Minister Abe

Today, we have sent our sincere condolences to the Japanese Association of City Mayors (JACM), expressing our deepest sympathy and feelings for the staff of JACM and the mayors of Japan as they experience the shocking loss of former Prime Minister Shinzo Abe who was assassinated yesterday in downtown Nara while delivering a campaign speech.

Our relationship with JACM goes back to the 1980s. We have had many workshops and forums to learn and exchange how we can together serve our people. One thing we learned about Japan, contrasting with the United States of America and even other nations, is the lack of guns and gun violence there. There is also a very low crime rate in general. No doubt, Prime Minister Abe's assassination by a 41-year-old man, a former Japan Maritime Self-Defense Officer, will rattle the nation and send shockwaves throughout the world since gun deaths are rare there as compared to here where we continue shooting
people and killing innocent Americans - men, women, children, and babies on a regular basis, like clockwork.

## Here's a Fact.

In 2018, Japan, a country of 125 million people, had nine deaths from firearms. The United States of America, in contrast, had 39,740.

In Japan, the only guns permitted for sale are shotguns and air rifles handguns are outlawed.

To qualify for a firearm license, one must attend an all-day class, pass a written test, and a shooting range test with an accuracy of at least $95 \%$.

In Japan, citizens must also undergo a mental evaluation and drug tests, plus a very rigorous background check, including a review of any criminal record, personal debt, involvement in organized crime, and relationships with family and friends.

The owner of a gun, once he or she is able to possess one, must register the weapon with the police and provide details as to where the gun and ammunition are stored, in separate, locked compartments. Police inspect the gun once a year. Gun owners must go through classes and rigorous examinations every three years.

Mere possession of a gun as part of an organized crime syndicate or gang gets you 15 years in prison. Possessing more than one gun is a crime that carries a prison term of 15 years.

Discharging a gun in a public space can result in a life sentence.
