The Everytown Survivor Network is a nationwide community of survivors working together to end gun violence. The Survivor Network connects survivors to each other, amplifies the power of survivor voices, offers trauma-informed programs, provides information on direct services, and supports survivors who choose to become advocates.

As you consider your response in the coming days, we wanted to share some information to help guide support for the grieving families, survivors of the shooting, as well as the broader community.

Community Response - Vigils: In the aftermath of a tragedy, some communities have organized vigils to remember the victims and to provide a space for members of the community to express their sorrow for the tragedy. Best practice from our experience is for these activities not to be political in nature and to be treated as a thoughtful remembrance gathering and an opportunity to show support to families. The families of victims may or may not choose to participate.

Support for Victims' Families and Witnesses to the Shooting: After a traumatic event, individuals respond in any number of ways. Many people are able to recover from their trauma using natural supports they have available to them. Others, however, may experience intense thoughts and feelings that last a long time.

Resources and Information: Here is some information on trauma and signs and symptoms of emotional trauma and coping tips for traumatic events and disasters. Our Resources page includes a list of crisis lines and resources to help identify sources of support in the Highland Park community. The Resources page also has several fact sheets on trauma and gun violence and coping with traumatic grief. Taking care of yourself is an important part of any recovery process. Self-care practices are those things we do for ourselves to maintain and improve our emotional, mental and physical wellbeing. Information on the importance of taking care of yourself can be found here.

Connection to Survivors of Other Shootings: If it would be helpful to the Highland Park community of survivors, the Everytown Survivor Network can connect individuals and families with survivors from other shootings and potentially other survivors of gun violence in the Highland Park area.

Dear Chief Jogmen:

The tattoos worn by Robert E. Crimo, III and his Twitter logo appear to me to be modified "Kek" symbols. The "Kekistan Movement" and a picture of a flag used by the movement is described by the Southern Poverty Law Center at the following link:

What the Kek: Explaining the Alt-Right 'Deity' Behind Their 'Meme Magic' Southern Poverty Law Center (splcenter.org) $^{\text {S }}$
His Twitter account logo appears to me to be a modified version of the complete "Kek" logo found in the center of the below pictured "Kekistan" flag. The hashmark tattoo on his face below his right eye appears to me to be a representation of the central symbol in the center of the "Kek" logo comprised of five vertical lines with opposing arrows, which appears to me that Crimo represented on his facial tattoo with four vertical lines and a horizontal crossing line. Additionally, you will note the leaves on the top of the below pictured "Kekistan" flag, and Crimo appears to have similar leaves tattooed on his neck.

Just sharing my personal observation in the interest of your investigation. I am NOT an authority on such symbols, and I may wrong but perhaps your investigators should consider the possibility of a connection between Crimo and the "Kek" movement.

#### Abstract

Yesterday was horrific and tragic day for Highland Park. As a community, we will come together and support each other through these difficult times. Senior staff met this morning and CMO and the Police and Fire staff provided the following information that I would like to share with all of you. If you have any questions, please feel free to reach out to Joel or me.

Crisis counseling is available for staff. Ghida sent out an email (attached) to All Users yesterday with the times. HR will send out information on additional support options in the upcoming days.


All requests for the media should be referred directly to Amanda Civitello and Erin Jason. Please do not supply interviews, conjecture or any other information. If you are asked questions by residents or customers, either in the field or in the office, please refer them to the City website home page. CMO is posting all updates on the website and that it the best source for information regarding yesterday's incident.

CMO is preparing a list of Q\&A to be posted on the City website regarding yesterday's events and subsequent relevant information. These will include most commonly or expected questions.

CMO is also preparing a standard response for staff to use when being asked about yesterday or subsequent actions. Once I get a copy of this I will provide it to everyone for use in the field, on the phone, at the front counter - where ever you may be asked questions. If you get unusual requests, please forward them directly to your supervisor who will send them to CMO.

CMO is in contact with the Park District, School districts, township and other sister agencies.
The FBI has secured the scene and is controlling all access to it. They will provide a phone number and central location where residents can collect their personal belongings left at the scene. This will be posted on the City website. Residents who left articles outside of the secured area can start collecting those belongings.

The area under control of the FBI is Green Bay Road to St. Johns and Elm to Laurel. The FBI will notify businesses within this area when they can reopen.

Food Truck Thursday is cancelled this week. Take Out Tuesday is also cancelled. If other events are to be cancelled, the Communication Director will send out a notice.

There are several vigils being held for the victims. Attendance is optional, but if you go please remember to direct those with questions to check the City website for information.


A Go Fund Me page has been set up for Highland Park. The City is not involved in this site nor is it involved in the collection or distribution of any funds pledged to it.

All volunteers for any purpose (clean up etc.,) and all donations of food, whatever, need to be logged. Volunteers should identify their name, their affiliated organization, and provide a contact number. All donations should be logged in as to estimated value, who donated them, when and where. Finance is keeping track of all donations of labor or materials.

After the shooting, the City Council had an emergency meeting and granted the City emergency powers that extend to finances, regulation (including drones) and expenditures.

If you receive any offers from social workers or psychologists wanting to donate their services, please direct them to the HR department.

Names of the victims have not yet been released. The Mayor intends to reach out to the families of those affected by the shooting.

A memorial will be located at City Hall for those who wish to place flowers and other items in honor of those impacted by the event.

## ITC: Psychosocial training and support

Horrific shooting incident on nation's celebration day in Highland Park, IL deeply shocked the whole community- the ripple effect of this horrific incident impacts many in different ways. For many individuals and families this event will remain a traumatic experience of their life for long time and the community will need some time to recover as well.

Over the next few days, the response, both operational and psychosocial, will transition from the immediate phase to providing a mid to long-term response, requiring comprehensive coordination, deliberate planning of emotional support provision to various circles of impact along the timeline, including identification of needs for these phases and availability of recourses.

In light of the reality described above, and based on our experience in supporting the psycho-social response to multiple incidents in Israel and around the world, the following steps are recommended:

- Identification, mapping and scoping of needs of different groups of people impacted by the incident in various intensity (families that lost their loved ones, survivors, parents/children of missing and dead, community institutions such as schools, first responders and care-providers etc.) including the projection of those needs' development along time, including various time marks (end of forensic procedures, funerals, back to school, holidays and so on).
- Identification, mapping and scoping of psycho-social support recourses (it should be kept in mind that such a transition also comes with withdrawal of "helping hands" that will be so useful during the first days and gradual decrease in availability of outside help. Also the initial response always characterized by certain level of duplications and deficits as one, due to the fact that multiple organizations are "jumping in" to help, not always in most coordinated way.
- Development of mid and long term, detailed and coordinated plan for prolonged psycho-social response, based on development of common language, utilizing all available community recourses (not only mental health professionals), progressing from short-term interventions, targeting acute trauma to full rehabilitation, focusing on It on strength and resilience of the community and its members.

From our perspective and experience, the recommended way to deal with these challenges is via a comprehensive systematic community approach that enables all the local agencies and stakeholders, formal and informal, to share their knowledge and resources and integrate their actions in favour of the community so that a continuum of care can be created in a shared language and culture of services.

ITC is capable and willing to share our expertise and experience in psycho-social response following traumatic events (by conducting online and offline training sessions) on following topics:

- Augmentation of local experts' capacity in trauma focused care for individuals, families and groups including but not limited to -

Following any traumatic event, that shatters one's routine and beliefs in life, it is natural to experience stress reactions that may feel different or more powerful than in everyday life Normal reactions to an abnormal situation


## Circles of Impact

In this kind of a crisis, there are various circles of impact, where the most vulnerable/affected persons are the ones most directly exposed.


## How to help children cope with grief and stress?

- Tell the truth about what happened.
- Be prepared for a variety of emotional responses.
- Be aware that your reactions and coping methods can be a model for your child.
- Help the child name their emotions and ensure them it's ok to feel this way.
- Be comfortable saying, "I don't know."
- Let the child grieve in his or her own way.
- Use relaxation techniques.


## Reach out for professional help if...

- Symptoms of stress as a result of for help.
- The first 48 hours might be shocking, and any symptoms you may experience would be normal.
- If the symptoms last over a month following the event, please reach out to a professional for help.



## Stress reactions can include-

- Intrusive thoughts and images, nightmares or flashbacks of the event.
- Emotional and physical reactions to the event while awake or dreaming.
- Avoidance and withdrawal, feelings of detachment and estrangement, loss of appetite, depression.
- Physical arousal, irritability or outbursts of anger, difficulty falling or staying asleep.
Normal reactions to an abnormal situation


## Parents: how to recognize signs of

 distress in your child?- Regressive behaviors such as: clinging, crying, bed-wetting, thumb-sucking.
- Aggressive behaviors such as: anger, risk-taking, impulsiveness.

- Avoidant behaviors such as: isolation.
Children usually react to the emotions of the adult around them. their reactions may vary in accordance to their age and stage of development

CHICAGO - Today Governor JB Pritzker issued a disaster proclamation for Lake County to assist in recovery efforts following Monday's mass shooting in Highland Park. A disaster proclamation grants the State of Illinois the ability to expedite the use of state resources, personnel, or equipment to help affected communities recover.
"There are no words for the kind of evil that turns a community celebration into a tragedy," said Governor JB Pritzker. "As we mourn together, the State of Illinois will provide every available resource to Highland Park and surrounding communities in the days and weeks ahead as the community works to recover from this horrific tragedy."
"I am devastated by yesterday's tragedy not just because it hit the very community I represent, but because mass shootings have become an all-too-common occurrence in this country that no city is immune to," said State Senator Julie Morrison (D-Lake Forest). "I pray for the victims and their families and vow to work together with my colleagues, local officials and Governor Pritzker on real, tangible solutions to ensure no other Illinois family has to experience this nightmare."
"My community is so grateful for the emergency declaration and the support the State of Illinois has already given, especially the immediate response from the Illinois State Police," said State Representative Bob Morgan (DDeerfield). Our needs will grow and evolve over time, and we know state government has our back as we continue to confront the reality of this horrific attack."

Lake County is the only county included in the disaster proclamation, which is effective immediately and will remain in effect for 30 days.

CHICAGO - Today Governor JB Pritzker issued a disaster proclamation for Lake County to assist in recovery efforts following Monday's mass shooting in Highland Park. A disaster proclamation grants the State of Illinois the ability to expedite the use of state resources, personnel, or equipment to help affected communities recover.
"There are no words for the kind of evil that turns a community celebration into a tragedy," said Governor JB Pritzker. "As we mourn together, the State of Illinois will provide every available resource to Highland Park and surrounding communities in the days and weeks ahead as the community works to recover from this horrific tragedy."
"I am devastated by yesterday's tragedy not just because it hit the very community I represent, but because mass shootings have become an all-too-common occurrence in this country that no city is immune to," said State Senator Julie Morrison (D-Lake Forest). "I pray for the victims and their families and vow to work together with my colleagues, local officials and Governor Pritzker on real, tangible solutions to ensure no other Illinois family has to experience this nightmare."
"My community is so grateful for the emergency declaration and the support the State of Illinois has already given, especially the immediate response from the Illinois State Police," said State Representative Bob Morgan (DDeerfield). Our needs will grow and evolve over time, and we know state government has our back as we continue to confront the reality of this horrific attack."

Lake County is the only county included in the disaster proclamation, which is effective immediately and will remain in effect for 30 days.

In 2019, the Highland Park Police Department had two recorded incidents involving Robert E. Crimo III.

The first was in April of 2019. A person contacted the Police Department and reported that Mr. Crimo had attempted suicide a week prior. There were no threats to public at the time the police were made aware of the incident, and we were informed mental health professionals were handling the matter.

The second incident occurred in September 2019. A family member reported that Mr. Crimo told him that "he was going to kill everyone," and that Mr. Crimo had a collection of knives. The Police responded to Mr. Crimo's residence. The Police removed 16 knives, a dagger, and a sword from Mr. Crimo's home. The Police had no cause to arrest Mr. Crimo at that time. The Highland Park Police did, however, immediately file a Clear and Present Danger report with the Illinois State Police.

The community has been incredible when it comes to providing investigators tips. Based on video surveillance recovered at the scene, investigators are aware there is a female witness who saw Crimo drop an object in a red blanket, behind Ross's at 625 Central Avenue, following the shooting. Thus far, we have not been able to identify that witness. We are asking, if you are the witness who saw this, please call 800-CALL-FBI.

We are also asking anyone with first hand information about Crimo that could be relevant to this investigation to contact 800 -CALL-FBI, but keep in mind we are looking for first-hand information, not information you've heard from another person.

A long weekend that should have been marked by celebration has instead left many of us deeply shaken.

Highland Park is a community that so many J Streeters call home, and yesterday's violence has left few lives untouched.

Together, we mourn the loss of seven lives needlessly cut short and hope for the swift and full recovery of those injured.

Three of those killed have been publicly named.
We remember Jacki Sundheim, a lifelong member of North Shore Congregation Israel, whose kindness and warmth touched so many in our community. We remember Nicolas Toledo, an active and funny grandfather who is today deeply missed by his children and grandchildren, who were with him yesterday. And we remember Stephen Straus, whose loving family describe him as an honorable, hardworking man who even at 88 still rode the train to work each day.

May their memories be a blessing.
In this moment, we also share anger and distress. The horror of yet another mass shooting has been visited upon an American community. It is truly intolerable.

We cannot accept this mass violence as normal or acceptable, nor can we accept the gun violence that upends so many lives across our city and the nation, but which does not make national headlines.

We must act to keep weapons of war off our streets, and we must rally together as a community to support those who are today experiencing a profound sense of loss, grief and insecurity.

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\section*{Highland Park Shooting: Seven Dead, More Than 30 Injured}

On Independence Day, we had to face another deadly attack in America. This time, it was in Highland Park, Illinois and the shooter fired 70 rounds from a rooftop during the city's 4th of July Parade. The shooter planned this attack for weeks and even donned women's clothing to ease his escape into the crowd. Law enforcement indicates that the shooter's choice of deadly weapon was "similar to an AR-15" and was purchased legally in the Chicago area.

Highland Park Mayor Nancy Rotering signed an ordinance almost a decade ago banning assault weapons. She said, the nation "needs to have a conversation about these weekly events involving the murder of dozens of people". While she said the person "clearly had a mental breakdown" the focus should be on access to guns, not mental health.

Find below a statement I released over the weekend, representing our organization:
"Today as we celebrate our nation's independence and the freedoms we enjoy, we are reminded that we are not free from gun violence and that nothing, not even a Fourth of July parade in a suburban community, is immune. Every day gun violence kills more than 100 people in our country. Today, in one community alone, at least six people are dead and dozens more injured, apparently because a young man had access to a high-powered weapon and decided to target innocent children and families celebrating our country's birth.
"The nation's Mayors stand with Highland Park Mayor Nancy Rotering, the police officers and other officials who quickly responded, treated the wounded and guided those at the parade to safety, and the entire Highland Park community. Once again, we send our condolences to the victims and their families.
"As the nation's mayors speak out once again to decry yet another mass shooting, along with a daily death toll that occurs on the streets of cities across the nation, we all must ask what else we can do to reduce gun violence in our country. The Bipartisan Safer Communities Act enacted just one week ago will help and is an indication that Congress can act, but as today demonstrates more must be done in our cities, our states and in Washington."

Joey Chestnut chomped his way to win a record-setting 15th win yesterday at Coney Island's Nathan's Hot Dog Eating Contest.

The 37 -year-old gobbled 63 hot dogs and buns in 10 minutes, which is far less than the 76 he devoured last year. He beat the person who came in second by 20 hot dogs. He had a brief interruption when an animal rights protester rushed him at one point. This disturbance lasted only a few seconds before the eating champ body slammed the man out of the way.

Today has been an incredibly tragic day in our community. Whether you were on site or watching the news unfold at home, we understand how traumatic the events of today have been on our City of Highland Park family. I am in awe and incredibly appreciative of the swift work that our emergency responders undertook when shots were fired in the business district. Police, Fire, Public Works, Admin and other employees as well as the community quickly worked to provide aide to individuals on the scene and police personnel immediately began the investigation which has now led the person of interest in custody. We are grateful to the immediate and on-going support from the FBI, Lake County Major Crimes Task Force, State, area law enforcement agencies and numerous other agencies and organizations.

First Responders Wellness Center will be on site at West Ridge Center, 636 Ridge Road at 10 AM, July 5 to provide trauma support and counseling to City Staff and the City Council as well as for our Government Partners. All team members are welcome and encouraged to attend if comfortable. Please note that the opening session at 10 AM is designed specifically for those that were on the scene today. Attached are three handouts for reference and below is the schedule for services.
- 10am, West Ridge Center - All team member who were at the Parade
- 11:30am, West Ridge Center - All team members who were in Highland Park today
- 12:30pm, West Ridge Center - All team members who would like additional support are encouraged to meet individually with a counselor from First Responders Wellness Center

Additionally, communitywide counseling services will be taking place at the High School in a joint effort by the City, Park District, and School District 112 and 113 from 9:00 to 2:00. No appointment is necessary, but only the Vine Street entrance will be open. Anyone who is not a current District 113 student or staff member who wishes to take advantage of counseling services will need to have valid State identification to be cleared to enter the school, which is the school's standard procedure for visitors.

Human Resources will be sending out information on additional support options in the coming days.
