On 8/26/12 at 10:58 Pm I, Ofc. Montemayor was on stationary patrol at the intersection of Park Ave. and Rt. 41 when I heard the sound of something being dragged or scrapping along the roadway. I then made visual with a white Ford Escort wagon driving South on Rt. 41 passing Park Ave West with what appeared to be a flat tire. As I pulled out and caught up to that vehicle bearing [REDACTED] I could see sparks coming from the rim as the driver, later identified as Denise Pesina, took a right turn exiting the Highway heading East on Deerfield Rd onto the overpass. I then initiated a traffic stop on said vehicle by activating my overhead emergency lights and spotlight. I advised dispatch of my location and observation.

As I made contact with Mrs. Pesina she shouted out to me through her window her tire was blown out and she didn't know what to do. I informed her that's why I pulled her over. I asked to see her drivers license and insurance card. As she handed me her identification card she stated the vehicle was her husband's and she would attempt to locate the insurance. During my conversation with Mrs. Pesina I could smell an odor of alcohol coming from her breath. She was also slurring her speech significantly. Ofc. Breitenbach arrived shortly afterwards to assist with the stop. As I returned to my vehicle I inquired into Mrs. Pesina's driving status. During this time she was able to locate her valid insurance policy.

Upon return to the vehicle I asked Mrs. Pesina to step out to show her the damage to her car. In addition I inquired as to Mrs. Pesina's whereabouts prior to being stopped. She stated she had just been at Wendy's which is where she first noticed her vehicle troubles. I then asked her where she was before that. She stated she was out seeing a friend. I advised her, based on the smell of her breath, it was obvious she had drunk alcohol and I wanted to know how much. She stated it wasn't a lot and admitted to drinking about two rum and cokes. She guessed her drinks were at around 6 PM.

At this time I advised her I was concerned about her ability to drive after drinking and requested to perform a series of tests to prove she was ok. I began with the Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus test. I asked Mrs. Pesina to place her hands at her side and if she could see the tip of my finger which she stated she could. I began to explain how to complete this test. Mrs. Pesina acknowledged she understood the test prior to starting. As I began I could see Mrs. Pesina was having a difficult time actually looking at my finger. After asking her to follow my finger multiple times she advised me it was difficult to do because of the flashing lights. I concluded it was a valid reason for her difficulty and advised her I would be turning off my front flashing lights and redirect the spot light to assist her in completing these tests.

After modifying the lighting I returned to Mrs. Pesina and repeated the test instructions. This time Mrs. Pesina could be seen making an attempt to follow the tip of my finger. Her eyes appeared very glassy and bloodshot. As she performed the test there was a lack of smooth pursuit as her eyes moved from left to right. As we continued the test Mrs. Pesina's eyes showed severe Nystagmus at a 45 degree angle. To conclude this portion of the test her eyes showed the same Nystagmus at maximum deviation.

I then moved onto the one leg stand test. As I explained the test Mrs. Pesina stated, " I can't do this normally. " Mrs. Pesina refused to complete this portion of the test.

I then moved onto the walk and turn test. I asked Mrs. Pesina to stand with one leg in front of the other touching heel to toe as I demonstrated. She was unable to stay in that position due to her issues with balance. It should be noted as I explained the test Mrs. Pesina made an attempt to start prior to my completion. Upon completion of my demonstration Mrs. Pesina stated she understood the test and began. She was having a difficult time touching heel to toe having several inches between steps. Mrs. Pesina also took 12 steps instead of 9 as instructed. She continued to step off the line as she returned back towards her car.

At this time I advised I had one final test consisting of the portable breath test. Mrs. Pesina was instructed how to complete the test which she did after a few attempts into the machine. The unit measured a .21. Mrs. Pesina had failed all portions of the field testing. Mrs. Pesina was then taken into custody for DUI. Mrs. Pesina did not initially cooperate while applying the handcuffs. Once the right cuff was applied she tensed up in an attempt to make cuffing more difficult. She was advised once again she was under arrest and to comply. After a couple attempts she finally allowed me to apply the last cuff, check for fit, and double lock. She was then escorted to Ofc. Breitenbach's awaiting patrol car where she was searched incident to arrest.

Mrs. Pesina was subsequently transported to the police station for processing. Mrs. Pesina was read her warning to motorist and Miranda Warning from a preprinted document which she stated she understood. It should be noted during this process Mrs. Pesina advised she had a really bad night. Aside from the DUI arrest Mrs. Pesina explained she was followed after leaving the bar " Mothers 2 " in the city by an unknown male white subject in his 20's trying to pull her over by using his vehicle aggressively. She further explained the unknown male subject threatened to contact police about her DUI status and [REDACTED]. Alarmed by the male's advances she reported to a nearby Chicago Police Station to find assistance. Mrs. Pesina observed Chicago Police officers speaking with the male suspect but later allowed him to leave. Mrs. Pesina further stated she was told to head home. Mrs. Pesina was surprised they didn't arrest her for DUI while in their presence. She then continued home where she saw her husband. She did not tell this information to her husband when she arrived. She then noticed she was hungry and decided to drive to Wendy's to pick up some food which is when she was stopped by me.

Ofc. DeCristofaro performed the breath operator duties and once the 20 minute observation period was completed Mrs. Pesina supplied a breath sample resulting in a .119 BAC. Mrs. Pesina made a phone call to her husband to arrange a ride home.

Mrs. Pesina was issued three citations which consisted of the following: #266483 Use of unsafe tire, #266484 Driving under the influence, #266485 for DUI bac over .08

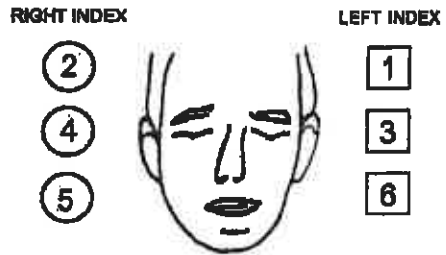

On Friday, 03/19/10, at approximately 8:22 AM, a 39 year old male, working as an agent of the Highland Park Police Department (HPPD), went in to Bob's Pantry and Deli (55 St. Johns Ave.). The agent attempted to buy both alcohol and tobacco products since Robert Crimo, the owner of the business, does not have a current permit to sell either alcohol or tobacco products from the City of Highland Park.

I observed the agent enter Bob's Pantry and Deli at approximately 8:22 AM. Prior to his entry in to the store, I searched his belongings to ensure that he was not in possession of any liquor or tobacco products. At approximately 8:24 AM, I observed the agent walk out of the store holding a pack of cigarettes.

Officer Spanos and I met with the agent right away. The agent handed us one pack of Marlboro Lights cigarettes and \$14.01 in change (he used a \$20 bill to purchase the cigarettes). The agent stated that he was charged \$5.99 for the pack of cigarettes. He further stated that he asked if they were going to give him a receipt and the female clerk with the short hair told him that he did not need one. As for the alcohol, the agent stated that the cooler doors are locked and there is a sign saying that they are waiting for their permit.

Officer Spanos and I took possession of the pack of cigarettes and the change. I took photos of the cigarettes and change.

Officer Spanos and I entered the store. We asked the clerk who sold the cigarettes, found to be Oliva Rodriguez, if Robert was around. She stated no but that his brother Paul was there. Officer Spanos spoke with Paul and asked him to call Robert. I spoke with Oliva, who stated that she was not aware that the store could not sell tobacco products.

Officer Spanos spoke with Robert over the phone. When advised that we were going to cite him for not having a license to sell tobacco products, Robert told Officer Spanos that he did not know that he needed one. Robert told Officer Spanos to give his citations to Paul.

I issued Robert administrative citation #HP013762 for license required for retail sale (125.003). The court date is set for 04/15/10 at 1:30 PM. I gave the citation to Paul.

I burned the video of our agent purchasing the tobacco on to a disc and entered it in to the BEAST as evidence. The property sheet is attached. I entered the photos in to Digital Evidence.

It should be noted that Officer Spanos cited Robert for selling tobacco without a license on 11/10/09. He also cited him that day for failure to obtain a restaurant license (115.010). After that administrative hearing, Robert obtained his 2009 tobacco license in December of 2009, which expired at the end of 12/31/09. Since the 2009 tobacco license expired, Robert has not possessed a 2010 tobacco license.

Cross reference this case with 10-03114 when Robert himself sold a pack of cigarettes to an agent on 03/16/10. He was also cited for that case.

On 06-15-22 at 4:52pm, Officer Stokes responded to [REDACTED] reference criminal damage to property at said location. Upon arrival, Officer Stokes spoke to homeowner [REDACTED] who related the following in summary:

On 06-14-22 he had a new fence installed on the south side of his property in his backyard that cost \$3,200.00. He stated the fence divides his property and his neighbors property located at 1566 McDaniels. During a recent storm, the old fence that belonged to his neighbor at 1566 McDaniels fell over and he consulted with his neighbor, Denise Pesina about replacing the fence stating he would purchase the new fence which she agreed to.

[REDACTED] said he applied for a permit and on 06-15-22 Nick Licari, Building Inspector from Public Works came to finalize the fence installation. Nick told him that his neighbor at 1566 McDaniels was upset over the placement of the new fence. [REDACTED] stated the fence was placed in the same location as the old fence and learned that the neighbor was Denise Pesina thought the fence was on her property.

Shortly after the inspector left, he heard a banging sound and went outside to look where the noise was coming from when he noticed his fence damaged. He said there were two wooden boards knocked down and laying in his back yard. He then spoke to his neighbor who lives across the street, [REDACTED] who told him he saw Denise Pesina with an axe and that she went back inside her house prior to him coming outside. He also informed Officer Stokes that he contacted the fence company regarding the cost for repairing the two boards and they gave him an estimate over the phone for \$700.00.

Officer Stokes spoke to [REDACTED] who lives at [REDACTED]. She said she did not see Denise near the fence but saw her exit her car with what looked like an axe. She could not describe the axe and stated her ring door bell does not capture Denise's driveway where she was exiting her vehicle or the fence.

Officer Stokes attempted to make contact with Denise Pesina at the front door of her residence located at 1566 McDaniels with negative results. Officer Stokes attempted to call Denise [REDACTED] with negative results. Officer Stokes then made contact with Bob Crimo [REDACTED] for assistance.

Mr. Crimo related that he does not reside at 1566 McDaniels, however he does have contact with his estranged wife, Denise. Officer Stokes advised him of the incident who offered to assist in trying to make contact with Denise regarding the damaged fence. He stated that Denise [REDACTED] and at times can be irrational. He responded to the house in attempt to make contact with Denise after attempting to call her several times with no answer.

Officer met with Bob Crimo at 1566 McDaniels and several attempts were made but Denise would not come to the door. Denise finally answered her phone and she denied having an axe or damaging the fence. She was yelling and talking about the fence being on her property and stated she was going to contact channel 7 news.

Mr. Crimo related that when Denise is acting in this manner, he can not reason with her. Mr. Crimo then met with [REDACTED] regarding the damaged fence. He apologized for the damage and asked if he could repair the two damaged boards. [REDACTED] agreed to allow him repair the two boards and told Officer Stokes that he did not want to sign a complaint. [REDACTED] said he has lived next to Dennis for several years and has never had an issue with her. He said he would rather just have his fence fixed and not stir up problems with her. [REDACTED] completed a witness statement as to what he told Officer Stokes.

Bob Crimo contacted Officer Stokes on 06-16-22 stating he replaced the two wooden fence boards and supplied the receipts to [REDACTED]. He said that he met with [REDACTED] who inspected the fence and stated it looked good.

Officer Stokes contacted [REDACTED] and confirmed he was satisfied with the fence repair done by Mr. Crimo and no further assistance was needed. Officer Stokes provided [REDACTED] with her business card should he have any other issues.

So, I called the inspector back. He did not want to get involved, so I called the police. I also called the fencing company, and they said the damage will cost about \$700 to repair.

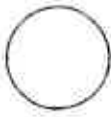

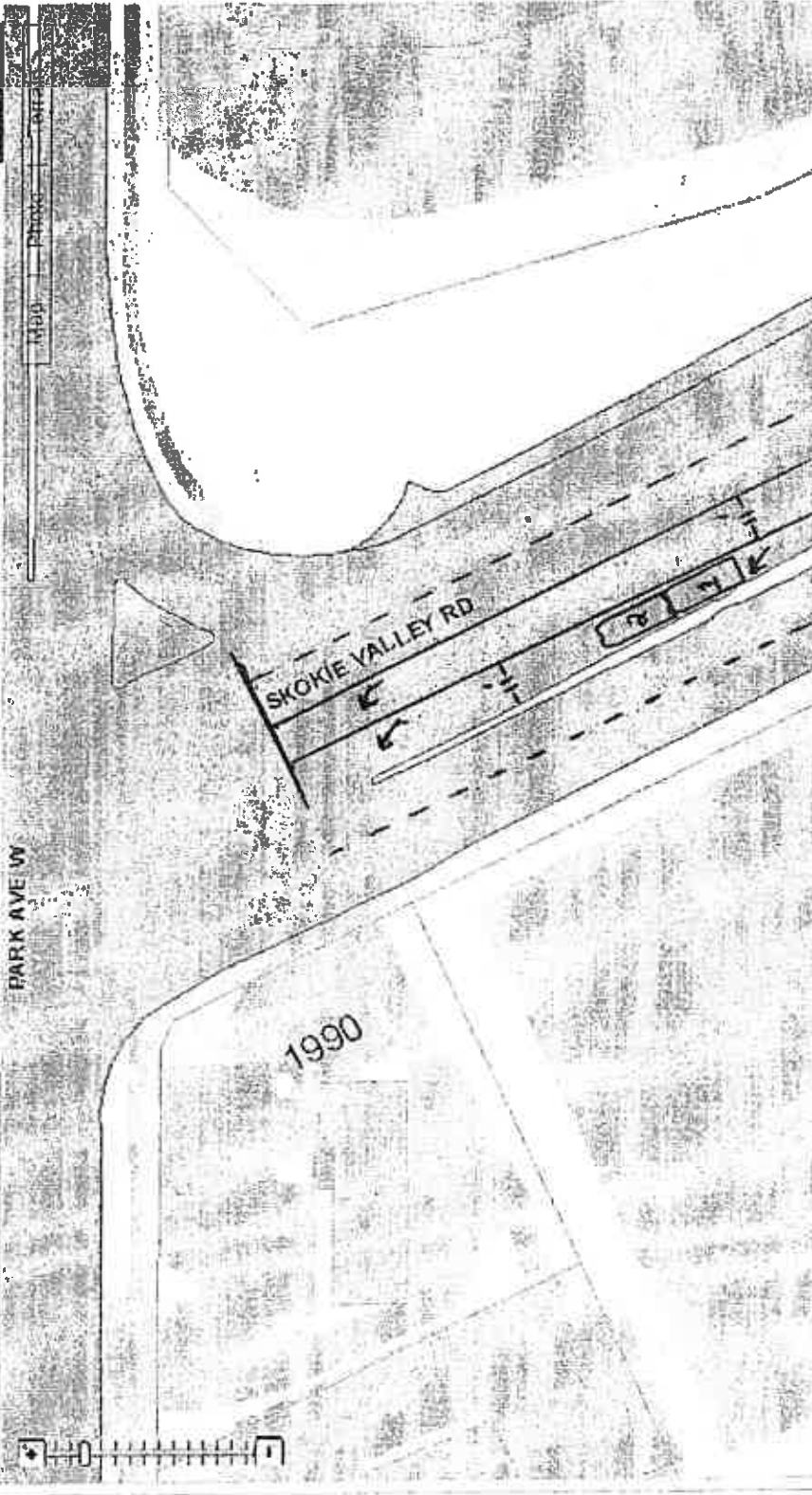
