

**SUPPLEMENTAL ORDERS  
PURSUANT TO DECLARATION OF EMERGENCY  
CITY OF HIGHLAND PARK  
MARCH 16, 2020**

I, Mayor Nancy R. Rotering, do hereby issue the following supplemental emergency orders for the City of Highland Park this 16<sup>th</sup> day of March, 2020 ("**Supplemental Orders**").

Introduction

On March 14, 2020, I issued a Declaration of Emergency pursuant to the authority granted to me by: Section 92.105 of "The Highland Park Code of 1968," as amended; Section 11-1-6 of the Illinois Municipal Code, 65 ILCS 5/11-1- 6; and Section 11 of the Illinois Emergency Management Agency Act, 20 ILCS 3305/11 to address the health threat posed by the COVID-19 pandemic ("**Declaration**").

The Declaration granted and reserved emergency powers to the Mayor during the pendency of the civil emergency, including the right to issue additional emergency regulations and orders in furtherance of the Declaration.

The corporate authorities of the City of Highland Park subsequently approved and extended the duration of the Declaration through and until the adjournment of the next regular or special meeting of the corporate authorities of the City.

Subsequent to the Declaration, Governor Pritzker issued a series of executive orders prohibiting gatherings of more than 50 persons, closing schools, and requiring all restaurants and bars to cease dine-in service statewide.

In order to prevent the spread of COVID-19 in the City, and to further protect the residents of the City from disease and death, I find that it is necessary to issue supplemental emergency orders as set forth below. Nothing in the Supplemental Orders shall modify or limit the actions and authority previously established by the Declaration.

Supplemental Orders

I hereby direct and order as follows:


Commencing at the end of their normal posted operating hours on Tuesday, March 17, 2020, the following business within the corporate limits of the City of Highland Park shall be closed and, for the duration of the Declaration, prohibited from operating as public accommodations open to members of the public:

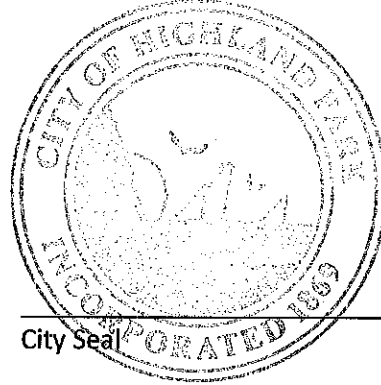
1. all "Health Clubs," as defined in the Highland Park Zoning Ordinance;
2. all "Clubs," as defined in the Highland Park Zoning Ordinance, maintaining and operating recreational or exercise facilities, including golf courses and tennis courts; and
3. all motion picture and live performance theaters.

These Supplemental Orders shall take effect immediately, and run concurrently with the term of the Declaration of Civil Emergency unless rescinded or superseded by my order or a majority vote of the corporate authorities at any regular or emergency meeting thereof.
