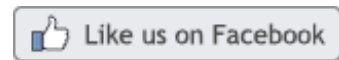

Did you know that seven out of ten US households (71%) have experienced some event in the past 12-month period that might have led them to hire a lawyer? The Highland Park-Highwood Legal Aid Clinic's mission is to provide access to legal representation for people who live or work in Highland Park and Highwood in the areas of housing, immigration and domestic violence.

Since opening its doors in May, 2015, the Clinic has helped nearly 200 people stay in their homes, gain legal status or escape an abusive relationship. Legal services are free to those that make less than 250% of the federal poverty guidelines (approximately
