

**Wolters Field Advisory Group Meeting**  
**Thursday, May 10, 2007**

- I. The following committee members were present;

- II. The 2006-07 light schedule was reviewed. There were 18 lighted events and 4 special nights when the lights had to be used for a short amount of time. Bobbie Monroe reported that on April 20, 2007, the lights remained on until 10:15pm due to a late start for the boys track invitational meet. Next year, every effort will be made to start the meet on time in order to ensure that the lights are off before the deadline.
- III. The 2007-08 Wolters Field lighted event was distributed. It is incomplete at this time. Brigid Ohlwein raised the concern of the Deerfield-Highland Park football game to be held at Wolters Field on October 5, 2007, in regards to the parking issue in the neighborhoods surrounding Wolters Field. A meeting between the HP police department and school officials will be held prior to that game to discuss parking issues.
- IV. Barry Bolek gave a presentation on the proposed renovations to the Wolters Field complex. Plans for the drainage, lay-out of the fields in the back, parking lot adjustments and new locker room facility were all part of the discussion. No major questions came from the group.
